

GUARDIANSHIP TERMS YOU SHOULD KNOW



APPLICATION FOR GUARDIANSHIP

The formal legal document filed with the court to request the appointment of a guardian for an incapacitated person.



INCAPACITY

Refers to the inability of an individual to make or communicate responsible decisions concerning their person due to a physical or mental condition.



GUARDIANSHIP

A legal relationship where a court gives an individual (the guardian) authority to make personal and/or financial decisions on behalf of an incapacitated person (the ward).



WARD

The individual who is determined to be incapacitated and in need of a guardian to make decisions on their behalf.



GUARDIAN OF THE PERSON

The individual appointed by the court to make personal, non-financial decisions for the ward, such as healthcare, living arrangements, and other personal matters.



GUARDIAN OF THE ESTATE

The individual appointed by the court to manage the financial affairs and assets of the ward.



ATTORNEY AD LITEM

An attorney appointed by the court to represent the interests of the incapacitated person during guardianship proceedings.



JBCC

The Texas Judicial Branch Certification Commission or "JBCC" is who is in charge of the training required to become a guardian.



LETTERS OF GUARDIANSHIP

The legal document issued by the court that authorizes a person to act as the guardian of the ward.



NOTICE

The formal communication of the guardianship proceedings to interested parties, including the incapacitated person, family members, and other relevant individuals.



ANNUAL REPORT

Required documentation filed by the guardian with the court detailing the ward's condition, the decisions made, and the financial status.
